

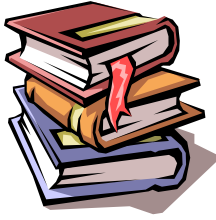

HEALTH CORNER

10/11-After complimentary breakfast by FIRE DEPT., they will discuss use of fire extinguishers, not smoking in bed & other useful tips in preventing house fires.

(Be sure to fast for these Tests)

10/25-Flu & Pneumonia shots will be given by the Health Dept. (FREE to medicare and Health First recipients. It's a \$25 charge, usually reimbursable, to those with private insurance).

HEALTH TIP:

The first step you can take to lower your sodium intake is to stop using the salt shaker entirely when cooking, baking, or sitting down to eat a meal. Another effective way to cut down is to eat fewer processed foods. Processed foods are those that are prepared commercially, including most canned, frozen, commercially baked, and dried foods. Try eating more foods in their natural, unprocessed state (such as fresh fruits & veggies, meat & poultry) and home-cooked "from scratch" meals. The more a food is processed, the more sodium it contains. Look what happens to plain potatoes or oatmeal:

Baked potato-1 medium-16 mg sodium

Instant mashed-1/2 cup-380 mg sodium

Old-fashioned/quick oatmeal-1 serving-(5 minutes to cook)-1 mg sodium

Instant oatmeal-(1 packet, 30 seconds to cook)-285 mg sodium.

When buying processed foods, look for:
Low-sodium, sodium-free, no salt added, or unsalted.

MEET YOUR NEIGHBOR

Joe Gonsalves was born and raised in New Bedford, Mass. He took up boxing, weightlifting and body building at age 14 and by the time he was 18 he had his own Gym and competed with his students in the New England area. He received his diploma from the Esther Swanson School of Massage at age 21.

Joe competed in body building for a while and unable to put on enough weight, transferred his interests to Judo and Karate. Eventually, Joe gave up his gym and concentrated on Martial Arts Training. He trained for Tae Kwon Do with a Korean Master who had moved to New Bedford and in 1972 Joe earned his Black Belt.

A few years later Joe opened his own Tae Kwon Do School and while he trained students in the martial arts his wife Irene managed the business end of the school.

Soon Joe's students began competing and won hundreds of state titles in Massachusetts, Connecticut, New Hampshire and Rhode Island. In addition there were two "PanAm" titles, eight "Nationals" and two "Outstanding Fighter" awards.

Joe also occasionally competed and received a "Gold" Medal and a student of his received the "Silver" Medal in "The Battle of Star Wars".

In 1976 Joe received his Masters and Fourth Degree Black Belt. After this he added Kick Boxing to his school program. He has trained a two time world champion, a national champion and an undefeated pro and had calls and letters from martial artists from Sweden, So. Africa and the Ukraine who wanted him as their teacher.

In 2002 Joe received his Grandmasters Degree and 8th Degree Black Belt.

Other honors include:

Induction into the World Martial Arts Hall of Fame in 1993; Most Outstanding Martial Artist of 1992; and Master Instructor of Year in 1991. He was also chosen for Martial Arts Elite International magazine, was the featured instructor of Tae Kwon Do Time Magazine International and has been certified by the WMAA. Last but not least he was inducted into "Who's Who in the Martial Arts".

In his spare time Joe was a Director in the "Annual Kickathon" for underprivileged children and a Director of the "Board Breaking Tournament" for St. Jude's Children Cancer Research Hospital. He also founded the Grand Master Gonsalves Tae Kwon Do Scholarship Fund.

Joe and Irene retired and moved to Lost Lakes in 2002 and he currently teaches Tai Chi at our clubhouse on Mondays and Fridays. We are certainly proud and happy that Joe and Irene live here.
