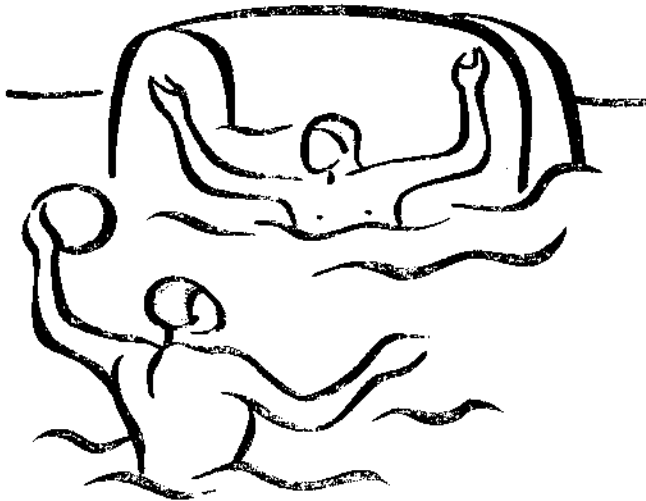

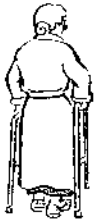

MEET YOUR NEIGHBOR

Our neighbor Joe Keller and his wife Mary have been in Florida since joining Lockheed Martin in Orlando in 1958.

While with Lockheed, Joe was awarded 3 gold medals in science for his work on the space program. There, he headed up a research program for Dr. Werner von Braun. Dr. von Braun, because of his achievement in conceiving and engineering the U.S. moon landing, was honored as the "Scientist of the Century." He also co-authored a technical paper with Joe.

For his patents and inventions, Dr. von Braun awarded Joe the U.S. National Reliability Award. Joe has published over 100 technical papers on electronics and has published a book and several video tapes.

One of Joe's patents was used by Microsoft and they incorporated his inventions into their interactive toy, BARNEY.

Joe left Lockheed to form his own international consulting corporation which he still owns. This work took him to over 40 countries. He is listed in "Who's Who" as an international expert. His inventions are used in computers, TV's, auto electronics and cell phones.

RESALE COMMITTEE UPDATE

We have now completed the age verification process and I wish to thank all residents for your help in achieving this goal.

At this time the number of members on the resale committee will be reduced to 4 to support ongoing resales and periodic review of age verification. The age verification process, which is required every 2 years per Federal Regulation 24CFR100.307, will be performed by comparing data on file to residents in the unit. All resales will require proof of age that 1 resident is 55 or older prior to closing.

The result to date of the age verification process is as follows:

# occupied homes	334
# 55 and over	325
# under 55	9
# unoccupied lots	16

The percentage of homes occupied by persons 55 or older is 97.3% which meets the federal and state requirement for housing designated as housing for older adults 55 and over.
