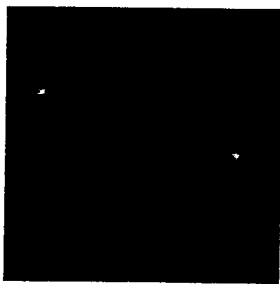
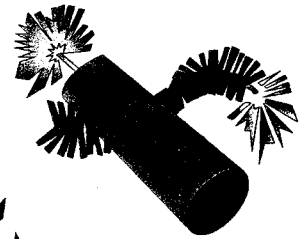


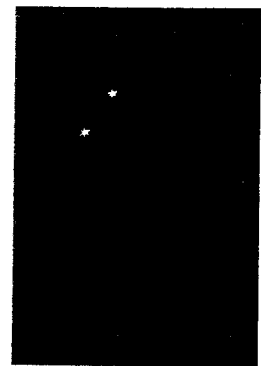

BREAKFAST

The next week we will know how many to plan for.

ARE YOU STICKERED?

If you do not have a BLACK sticker on your window, then please read this:

At the time you bought your home, you were issued a sticker for each section of home. If you were issued a BLACK sticker, it should read "Permanent RP" (Real Property). That is the one every one should have.

Read on if you do not have a BLACK sticker.

If you do not have a BLACK sticker, take your colored sticker and vehicle refistration papers, or just your vehicle registration papers to the Clerk of Courts Building. It is on 2575 N. Courtney, One block south of 528, on the corner of Heidi Land and N. Courtney. Go to the Homestead Exemption room 130. They will issue you a "Declaration of Mobile Home Real Property" paper. There you can also file or homestead exemption if you qualify.

Take this "Declaration of Mobile Home Real Property" and your stickers and/or registration papers to Brevard County Tax Collector at 1450 Courtney. Go south to Victoria Square (on your left) at the Winn Dixie. This is south of the Clerk of Courts. (Just past Target).

They will process your paper work, charge you a nominal fee, and let you know if you qualify for a refund for your non permanent stickers. Then affix your BLACK sticker on a window in the front of your house.

Why should I do this you may ask? Because if you have temporary stickers they expire each year, and you will be required to pay at least \$200 or more each year. Besides your house is attached to land that you own, so you are classified as Real Property.
