His hobby is collecting submarine insignias from around the world and, as for recreation, he plays golf.

### HEALTH TIP: Why watch your salt intake?

Too much salt (sodium chloride) isn't good for anyone especially if you have heart failure (HF). If there's too much sodium in the food you eat, your body holds too much fluid (water), making your heart work harder. When you take in less sodium, your heart has less work to do. The body **ONLY NEEDS** about 500mg of sodium daily or 1/4 teaspoon of salt. The American Heart Ass'n. recommends 2400mg daily or **LESS** for the American population and 2000mg or **LESS** for patients with (HF).
